exe and called it a day (0x80073713) If you're into this sort of thing, you can find the same issue with a number of anti-malware products and here's a fix from this thread on Microsoft's webmaster forum. Also, there was a really disturbing warning/error message that appeared on the repair screen. It said to restart the PC and then: Windows Error Recovery is checking for system changes and repairing your computer at this time. Then it asked if you want to restart the computer again right away, yes or no, and you had to answer right away. After the repair/restart it said the same thing: The two solutions in the first post mentioned above did not work for this particular fix, but an unmentioned third (that actually worked) is here. Note: I got the best results using a Windows 7 live disc. All of this is relevant to both Windows 8 and Windows 7 users. However, the fix I linked to is specific to Windows 7. I spent a lot of time searching to try to find a good solution but it doesn't look like there's a fix at this time. The last work around I have found was to use System Restore to delete the problematic temp files. The files can be deleted without harming your system and restored as needed. 1. Start Windows and log into your account. 2. Click Start then select All Programs then Accessories. 3. Scroll down to System Tools and click System Restore 4. Click on the restore point that was created after you originally installed Windows 7. 5. Then click Next. 6. Type in the name of the file that has the problem into the Name: box, e.g., "repair.exe". 7. Click on the OK button to confirm the name of the file you are restoring from. 8. Click on Next. 9. Select the first option, Recovery and click on the Next button. 10. You should be taken to a screen that tells you to pick a restore point that you want to restore and click on the Next button. 11. Follow the instructions to pick a restore point and click on the Next button. 12. You'll be brought back to the System Restore screen and you can
